

Migration Vocabulary Notes:

Define (or review) the following basic terms.

- Migration – a movement of people from one region to another
- Internal migration – a movement of people from one region to another *within the same country*.
 - (Contrast with: Immigration – a movement of people *into* a new country; and Emigration – a movement of people *out* of a home country.)
- Push factors – circumstances that repel, or push, people out of a place or region
- Pull factors – circumstances that attract, or pull, people into a place or region
- Enablers – circumstances that supply people with the means and opportunity to move from one region to another
